Because our funds are limited, we ask that only those City of Dallas residents who cannot afford to sterilize their pet(s) use this coupon. **This program is for surgery and pain medication only.** Any additional veterinarian vaccinations/expenses are the responsibility of the pet owner – see complete information on back of this page.

RABIES VACCINATIONS ARE REQUIRED BY LAW FOR ALL DOGS & CATS!

- The MAC program pays *ONLY* for the spay/neuter surgery and *ONLY* for animals that are owned pets.
- **Due to restricted funding and current high demand, our program is limited to City of Dallas residents’ pets and highest priority will be given to the following zip codes:**
75203, 75211, 75212, 75216, 75217, 75224, 75227, 75228, 75232, 75233, 75236, 75237, 75241, 75253, 75224
- **Understand what shots your animal needs and any other items you will be charged for.**
- Additional requirements vary from clinic to clinic, as stated above.
- If it is necessary to miss an appointment, **BE SURE TO CALL THE CLINIC AND CANCEL** – others are waiting for your time slot.

NOTE: MAC DOES NOT SPAY/NEUTER FERAL CATS.
